As part of the scholarship application, the University of Phoenix will review the applicant's official University of Phoenix student account and transcripts to verify the following requirements: i. Applicant has not had an unapproved attendance break of greater than 14 days in the last 365 days as of the Scholarship application deadline. iii. Applicant has a minimum GPA of 3.75 (on a 4.0 scale) as of the Scholarship application deadline Applicant must be actively enrolled and attending the University of Phoenix for a bachelor's degree program within the Initial Attendance Window.
Selection Process	 The recipients of the scholarships will be selected by the University of Phoenix.
