

Summary	<p>All new students or students who have been out of attendance for over 365 days who i) apply for and enroll in a University of Phoenix bachelor's degree program; (ii) have three year's work experience and (iii) apply for this Phoenix Bachelor's Scholarship – October 2022 ("Scholarship") prior to the deadline and register and post attendance in their first class between October 1st, 2022 and October 31st, 2022 ("Initial Attendance Window") will receive a scholarship up to \$1,000 each.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Students must begin the admissions application prior to completing this scholarship application</p>
Application Deadline	<p>The Scholarship application will be made available online on September 1st, 2022. Applications must be completed and submitted online at www.phoenix.edu by 11:59pm MST October 31st, 2022 ("Application Deadline"). Applications submitted after the Application Deadline will not be considered. No exceptions.</p>
Eligibility Criteria	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Applicants currently residing in the United States must meet one of the following requirements: be a legal resident of the United States; have been granted permanent residency; have a valid visa that does not prohibit educational studies; have been granted temporary protected status along with approved Notice of Action issued by Citizen Immigration Services and verified through CIS Form g-845; or have been granted asylum along with the approved Notice of Action issued by the Citizen Immigration Services. 2. Applicant must meet all admissions requirements of University of Phoenix if selected as a scholarship recipient. 3. Applicant must not be an employee (including full- and part-time faculty)

The University of Phoenix treats this tuition scholarship, in the form of a non-cash award, as non
