

The Transfer Student Bachelor's Scholarship – May 2024

Selection Process	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The recipients of the scholarships will be selected by the University of Phoenix. 2. It is the applicant's responsibility to submit a complete and signed application along with any required and supporting documentation, which must be received on or before the Application Deadline. The University of Phoenix accepts no responsibility for incomplete applications, applications not in proper form, lost applications, or any other submission in exception to the instructions. 3. Scholarship selection shall be made without regard to race, color, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, national origin, disability, veteran status, or any other category protected by federal, state, or local law. 4. The decision of the University of Phoenix is final and not subject to review. 5. Starting on June 1st, 2024, the University of Phoenix will begin the selection process for eligible qualified students. 6. Recipients will be notified no later than July 1st, 2024.
Scholarship Award Distribution and Timing	<p>The University of Phoenix will determine and notify the recipients of the scholarships upon validation.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. The maximum scholarship award is \$3,000. The Scholarship shall be disbursed as a credit toward the student's tuition payments at a rate of \$150 per course beginning with the student's first attended course and thereafter for those continuously attended courses in their bachelor's program until: (i) the student has maximized the \$3,000 Scholarship amount, or (ii) two years (730 days) has elapsed from the student's first course start date notwithstanding any approved leave of absence(s), or (iii) the student graduates from their program, whichever comes first. Subsections (i)-(iii) are collectively hereinafter referred to as "Terminating Events". 2. Only the applicants selected as Scholarship recipients will be notified by the University of Phoenix.
Maintenance Requirements	<p>In order to continue disbursement of the scholarship award, applicant must meet the following maintenance requirements:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Applicant must remain in a bachelor's program (all coursework attended must be program applicable courses). Awards will only be applied to courses taken as part of their bachelor's program, specific to the or s prc
